Brief Preparations Document for the ICJ

By the Presidency and the Secretariat of Haarlem Model United Nations

In the following document, you will find a list of what we ask all court members to bring and prepare for the ICJ. However, we encourage you to look at the other document where you will find a more detailed explanation. All documents and information can be forwarded to the <u>icj@hmun.nl</u>

Advocates

- Opening Statements (15-minute maximum).
- Hand in their Memorandum (1 week before the court: 24th of March).
- Hand in their Stipulations (1 week before the court: 24th of March).
- Hand in all Evidence (1 week before the court: 24th of March). Send in all evidence they want to use during the procedure via the Presidency and the Register. They will see if the evidence is presentable to the court (10 pieces maximum).
- Print out three copies of all evidence before the court.
- Hand in Witness list (3 maximum) (1 week before the court: 24th of March).
- Closing speeches (max 20 minutes).

Registrar

- Judge whether the evidence is suitable and properly formatted in consultation with the Presidency (1 week before the court: 26th of March).
- Label the evidence "1" and "A" etc in a booklet.

Judges

- Prepare questions for the advocates.
- Do your research on the case, however, do not enter the court with any bias.
- After seeing the witness list, prepare questions for the witnesses.
